

COVID-19 INFORMATION

Here at Earthshine Lodge, we are committed to providing a safe and healthy environment for our guests, our staff, and our community. Offering lodging and outdoor adventures is at the heart of what we do, and we want to ensure that everyone can enjoy the mountaintop safely and comfortably.



WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT:

We are grateful that Covid-19 restrictions around the country are being lifted, but also want to ensure that we're sensitive to the needs of all our guests. As conditions change, we will update our policies to reflect the most up to date information.

- We will continue to offer flexible reservations. If you need to change your reservation last minute due to COVID-19 travel concerns, you may move it to another date without any fee. With this in mind, we ask that you please:
 - Do not travel if there is a chance you have been exposed to COVID-19.
 - Stay home if you are showing any symptoms or are not feeling well.
- A sense of community is one of the most loved aspects of the Earthshine experience. We want to ensure that we are sensitive to those who haven't yet had the opportunity to be vaccinated, so for the time being, we encourage you to:
 - Please continue to social distance with those who are not traveling with you.
 - Any guests or staff who have not been fully vaccinated must wear a mask inside the common areas of the lodge (except while actively eating or drinking).
 - Take advantage of the hand sanitizer stations that are located around the common areas.

OUTDOOR ADVENTURES:

We have a calendar full of outdoor adventures for all ages and we hope that you take advantage of the exciting things happening at Earthshine Lodge. A few things to keep in mind:

- We will be taking extra precautions to maintain social distancing and disinfecting while exploring and ask that you do the same (i.e., add hand sanitizer and masks to your packing lists!)
- While we no longer require masks for outdoor activities, we ask that you bring one along in case a situation arises (such as administering first aid or getting a closer look during activity instruction) that forces group members to be closer to each other than normal.
- Private experiences: If you would like to schedule an activity with just your family or group, outside of what is offered on the calendar, please do not hesitate to ask!
