10:00 - 11:30am	 A simple guide to editing your images. Using Lightroom and Photoshop, Nelson will share his workflow and how to edit your images. He will edit one stacked image and one long exposure image. Bring your own computer (with all equipment needed) loaded with Lightroom and Photoshop if you would like to follow along with post processing of your images.
Noon - 1pm	Lunch - "stay and eat" or "grab and go"
